

NOTICE is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City of Somers Point (hereinafter called the "Owner") for:

Sealed bids for the above named Contract, which comprises of the SOMERS POINT BIKE PATH WIDENING in the Municipality of Somers Point, Atlantic County, New Jersey ("Owner"), will be received at the City Clerk's Office in City Hall, 1 W. New Jersey Avenue, Somers Point, New Jersey 08244 on Tuesday, September 24, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. prevailing time, at which time they will be publicly unsealed and the contents publicly announced.

The work includes the furnishing of all labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the work as shown on the Drawings and as described in the Specifications. The work on Contract No. 39 consists of the widening of the existing bike path and installing new pedestrian lighting as indicated on the plans. The work includes the furnishing of all labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the work as shown on the Drawings and as described in the Specifications. The work shall be completed within one hundred and fifty (150) calendar days of the Contractor's receipt of written Notice to Proceed.

Successful bidders, after notification of award, but prior to signing a construction contract, shall submit to the City and the Dept. of LWD, Construction EEO Monitoring Program an initial project workforce report (Form AA 201) electronically provided to the public agency by the Dept. LWD, Construction EEO Monitoring Program, through its website http://www.state.nj.us/treasury/contract_compliance_/pdf/aa201.pdf for distribution to and completion by the contractor, in accordance with the N.J.A.C. 17:27-7. The contractor also agrees to submit a copy of the Monthly Project Workforce Report once a month thereafter for the duration of this contract to the Dept. of LWD, Construction EEO Monitoring Program and to the public agency compliance officer

The provisions of the Federal Government Department of Labor's current wage rate determinations and the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act are requirements of this project. The higher of the Federal or State Wage Rate and the higher of the Federal or State Fringe Benefit Rate shall prevail.

The number of Training Positions will be 0 [where feasible consisting of at least Zero (0) Apprentices and Zero (0) Apprentice Graduates of the P.A.P and/or Trainees (Total Trainees Hours = 0)]. The Disadvantage Business Enterprise goal is 5%.

Proposals are being solicited through a fair and open process in accordance with N.J. S.A. 19:44A-20.2, et seq., and as such, contractors are exempt from the limitations on making political contributions under that law. Further, for that reason, as well as because of a language in the New Jersey's Annual Appropriations Act, refusal to disclose campaign contributions otherwise required by N.J. S.A. 19:44A-20.2 et seq. and 19:44A-20.25 et seq., will not adversely affect your consideration for award.

No bid will be received unless in writing on the forms furnished, and unless accompanied by bid security in the form of a bid bond or certified check made payable to the Owner in an amount equal to 10% of the amount of the total bid, provided that the said security need not be more than \$20,000 nor less than \$500.00 and be delivered at the place on or before the hour named above.
